Peru, South America – orphanage program - ongoing

Zimbabwe, Africa – sponsoring a young woman for higher education, for the length of her course (currently applying for x-ray technician)

Local Community Programs

Trent University and Fleming College Awards - given annually

Cameron House for women–gardening, visiting, programming opportunities

Homeward Bound – a program supporting homeless or inadequately housed single mothers to earn college diplomas, start careers and achieve financial self-sufficiency.

The Daughter Project - Daughter Project Canada was established in 2015, as a direct response to the growing need for anti-sex trafficking resources in our country. The not-for-profit organization works to "help those at risk of child sex trafficking and sexual exploitation by bringing awareness, creating

prevention methods, and providing treatment to those who have been impacted." The first home in Canada, for human trafficking victims will be located in Peterborough.

Happy Project – partnership with Costco/PWD to collect and distribute surplus demonstrator products (currently in hiatus due to Covid19)

Elizabeth Fry Society – gift bags for women at Christmas and therapeutic art program

Tulip Garden and Bench – Del Crary Park in Peterborough

Delta Bingo and Gaming – club members volunteer at the venue and our club promotes their charitable gaming activities. Proceeds are distributed monthly to our club.
